Rimrock Grand Prix - FAQ

- 1. Sign-up and get your punch tag <u>before</u> going to the sound test. Sound test required. Max 102dB for air-cooled bikes and 98dB for water-cooled.
- 2. Zip tie the punch tag to the left handlebar. No RFID for scoring this year.
- 3. Display your class designating letter on all three number plates. The letter must be large enough so that it is easily read.
- 4. Attach the club issued rider bib so the number is clearly visible on your chest and on your back.
- 5. 8:30 Rider's Meeting. No parade lap.
- 6. 9:15 Kidz Race. The 8 & under class will race for 20 minutes and the 9-12 class will race for 30 minutes.
- 7. 10:30 Race starts for the short course classes and will be 1 ½ hours long.
- 8. 1:30 Race Starts for the expert Long Course Classes and will be 2 ½ hours long.
- 9. 2:00 Trophy presentation for Short Course and Kidz.
- 10. A second Trophy presentation will follow scoring the Long Course race.
- 11. No trophies will be given out before the trophy presentation and no trophies will be mailed.
- 12. Race results will be posted near sign-up area ASAP following scoring.
- 13. See list below for the number of trophies for each class.
- 14. Live engine wave start in the order listed below.
